KC South is implementing a Code of Conduct for the 2025-2026 season. This agreement must be signed by the Guardian in order to participate in team events – both on and off the ice.

Failure to comply with the Player's Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary actions as outlined in the Code of Conduct and the associations Policies and Procedures.

Physical abuse of another person will carry an indefinite suspension from the team until further reviewed by the Coaching staff and association representatives.

The following is intended to act as a "Code of Conduct" and will serve as KC South's team guidelines for management and protection of rights and privileges of all team members.

As a player in KC South Minor Hockey Association, Hockey Alberta, and Hockey Canada, I shall be subject to the following *Code of Conduct*, *both ON and OFF the ice*. Should I choose to break these codes, I understand that I will be subject to disciplinary measures, which may include:

- Benching (during a game or practice);
- Suspension from practices and/or games;
- Prohibition from skating, practicing, or participating in team events;
- Dismissal from the team and potentially the association.

Disciplinary measures may be administered by my coaches, the team manager, or by a member of the KC South Board of Directors.

Purpose of this Code of Conduct

This code of conduct is intended to promote and ensure acceptable behaviour by person's involved with the KC South Hockey Association.

Fair Play Code for Players

I will abide by Hockey Canada's Fair Play Code for Players:

- I will play hockey because I want to, not just because others or coaches want me to.
- I will play by the rules of hockey, and in the spirit of the game.
- I will control my temper fighting and "mouthing off" can spoil the activity for everybody.
- I will respect my opponents.
- I will do my best to be a true team player.
- I will remember that winning isn't everything that having fun, improving skills, making friends, and doing my best are also important.

KC South Code of Conduct

• I will acknowledge all good plays/performances – those of my team and of my opponents. • I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me. I will accept their decisions and show them respect.

Behaviors that have a ZERO TOLERANCE:

I understand that the following behaviors will not be tolerated by my coaches, my team manager, or the association members:

- Theft
- Vandalism.
- Fighting.
- Bullying.
- Cyberbullying.
- Abusive language or behaviour.
 Poor sportsmanship

- · Locker room "trashing".
- Unacceptable behaviour or

harassment.

• Disrespect to referees, visiting hockey team officials or players, rink

personnel, any other player, coach, official, parent, spectator, association volunteer, or team official.

Definition of Unacceptable Behavior and Harassment

Unacceptable Behaviour: An individual is displaying unacceptable behaviour if they are verbally, in writing, or physically harassing and/or abusing a player, coach,

official, parent, spectator, association volunteer, or team official.

Harassment: Harassment is defined as conduct, which is disrespectful, insulting, intimidating, humiliating, offensive, or physically harmful to any player,

coach, official, parent, spectator, association volunteer, or team

official.
